4 Things North Texas Summers Do to Your Home

Summer in North Texas isn't just hot — it's hard on your home's indoor air quality. Here's what's actually happening:

TIP 1

Your AC vents are working overtime. When your system runs all day, it pulls in more dust, pollen, and pet dander than any other season. Wipe down your registers with a damp cloth every two weeks and change your filter monthly.

TIP 2

More foot traffic = more tracked-in grime. Kids home from school, backyard BBQs, wet dogs. Summer is the highest-traffic season in most Allen homes. Your entryways and mudrooms need extra attention right now.

TIP 3

Humidity breeds mold in hidden spots. North Texas summers bring enough humidity to encourage mold growth in bathrooms, under sinks, and around windows. Keep an eye on grout lines and caulking.

TIP 4

Pet dander peaks in summer heat. Dogs and cats shed more in warm weather, and your AC system recirculates that dander all day long. If anyone in your home deals with allergies, summer is the season to stay ahead of it.

Hot Weather & Your Dog: 3 Things to Watch For

If you've got dogs or cats at home, keep these in mind as the heat picks up:

Watch the floors. Hot pavement outside means your dog's paws track in more debris when they come inside. A quick wipe at the door goes a long way.

 RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Easy Summer Lemonade Chicken

Simple, fresh, and it won't heat up the whole kitchen.

What you need: 4 boneless chicken breasts · 1/2 cup fresh lemon juice · 2 tbsp olive oil · 2 cloves garlic · 1 tsp honey · Salt, pepper & fresh rosemary

1. Mix lemon juice, olive oil, garlic, and honey. Season with salt and pepper.
2. Marinate chicken for at least 30 minutes.
3. Grill on medium-high, 6-7 minutes per side.
4. Garnish with rosemary and lemon. Serve with grilled corn.
